- 1. Purpose: These Selection Guidelines are promulgated to acknowledge students at National Taiwan Normal University (the "University") who excel both in character and studies and have demonstrated excellent achievements.
- 2. Time of selection: Excellent students are selected once per academic year in the fall semester.
- 3. Eligible candidates: All undergraduate students at the University who have a GPA of 3.5 or higher in each semester, excluding students who undertook a suspension of studies in the previous academic year, and who have not received any disciplinary punishment may be eligible.
- 4. Selection criteria: Students who have demonstrated excellent achievements in at least two of the following areas during their studies and have specific contributions that allow them to serve as exemplary models may be nominated by their department as candidates.
 - (1) Students who have participated in intra- or extramural activities, serving the community with passion and philanthropic spirit and acting as a role model for their peers.
 - (2) Students who have published creative works, inventions, designs, technical patents or research findings that contribute to the reputation of the University.
 - (3) Students who have represented the University to compete in sports competitions at home and abroad with outstanding results.
 - (4) Students who have served as an officer of a class, student union, student council, or clubs either in or outside the University, setting an example for their peers.
 - (5) Students who have participated in arts and culture related competitions, performances and exhibitions at home and abroad with outstanding achievements.
 - (6) Students who have demonstrated excellent achievements in other areas equivalent to those listed above.
- 5. Quota and selection method: Each department may nominate one student each academic year, and the nomination method shall be determined by each department.
- 6. Reward and recognition:

Selected students will be:

- (1) awarded a certificate of selection and a scholarship of NT\$5,000;
- (2) awarded a minor merit;
- (3) and commended at a Student Affairs meeting or at an important University assembly.
- 7. The scholarship is funded by the student public funds and incentive funds of the University.
- 8. The award will be recorded in the student's e-Portfolio in the University.
- 9. These Selection Guidelines and any amendments thereto become effective after approval by the Student Affairs Director's Committee and ratification by the University President.
