National Taiwan Normal University Guidelines for Student Conduct Score

Conversion

Approved at the Student Affairs Committee in the 2nd semester of 2012-2013 academic year on April 24, 2013; effective from the 1st semester of 2013-2014 academic year

- 1. The National Taiwan Normal University Guidelines for Student Conduct Score Conversion (the "Guidelines") are promulgated to assist students to apply for off-campus scholarships or for other requirements.
- 2. The actual conduct score for each semester is calculated by adding or subtracting any points from the rewards or disciplinary actions during the semester to the student's base score of eighty seven. The maximum student conduct score shall be ninety five.
- 3. The rules for adding or subtracting conduct score for rewards or disciplinary actions are as follows:
- (1) Plus one point for each commendation, plus 2.5 points for each minor merit, plus 7.5 points for each major merit, and plus 10 points for receiving a university motto certificate of exellence.
- (2) Deduct one point for each warning, deduct 2.5 points for each minor demerit and deduct 7.5 points for each major demerit.
- 4. Student conduct scores are classified as follows:
 - (1) A score of ninety or higher: Outstanding.
 - (2) A score eighty to eighty nine: Grade A.
 - (3) A score seventy to seventy nine: Grade B.
 - (4) A score sixty to sixty nine: Grade C.
 - (5) A score lower than sixty: Grade D.
- 5. The student's conduct score and grade certificate shall be issued upon application.
- 6. These Guidelines and any amendments thereto become effective after approval by the Student Affairs Committee and ratification by the University President.
